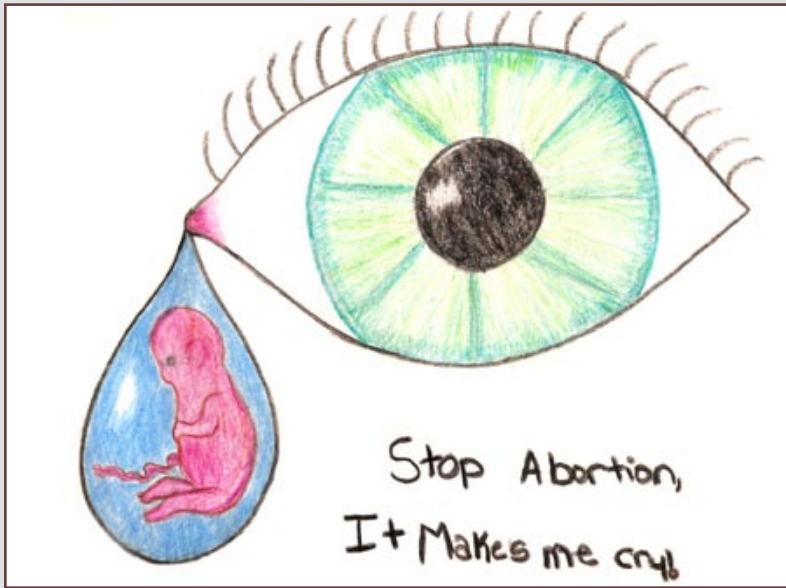


## Festival Success

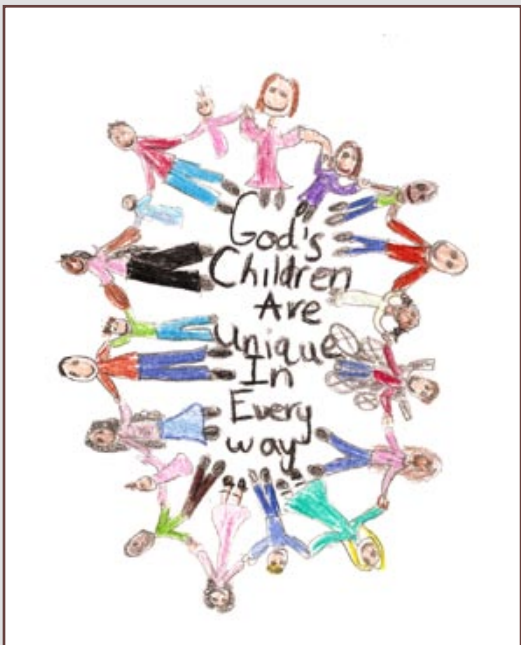
