Best Spicy – Mike Wesley



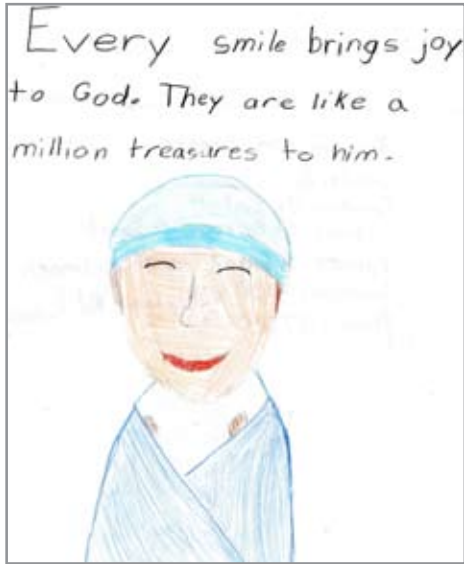
Recruitment Award
