## Holy Family Shrine Mass Sept. 18th

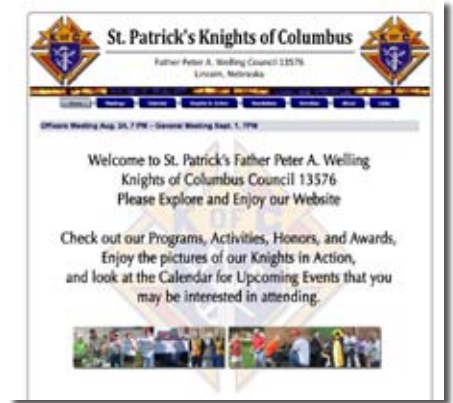
An 8 a.m. Mass is planned at the Holy Family Shrine. Exit 426 on I-80. All are welcome.
