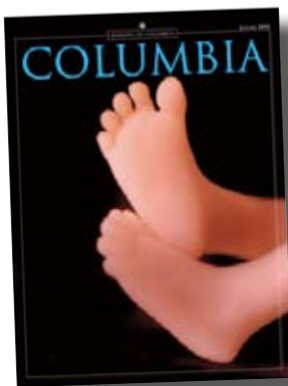

As Knights of Columbus member you have access to **Columbia** magazine. The January 2011 edition has several excellent pro-life articles. As Dick Zierke pointed out at Wednesday's meeting, one article "Good Medicine" has ties to Lincoln Pius X High. Another article - "The Quest for a Cure" is about continued advancements in ethical

stem cell research. Following the article is interview Columbia magazine conducted with an "internationally recognized expert on stem cells and cloning." It's one of the best one page explanations of Stem Cells I've ever seen. Content is easy to understand.

Other sources you have access to are copies of **Celebrate Life** magazine found on the stand in vestibule of St Pat's. Celebrate Life is a major pro-life publication with a Catholic perspective. Currently there are approximately 10 copies of July-August issue and Fall 2010 issue. (Publisher changed editors thus there was no September-October edition.) As mentioned in church bulletin of 01/02/11, July-August edition has article with ties to UNL Newman Center and a previous vocations director. All editions of Celebrate Life magazine have articles by a stem cell expert. Both of the above editions document how minority groups are targeted by the abortion industry.
