Pro Life Insights

To all knights and family members who participated in anyway in get pro-life bills LB 22, 521, and 690 passed by the Nebraska Unicameral.

The following is loosely adapted from Greg Schleppenbach's "Life Insight" column, 05/20/11 edition of Southern Nebraska Register.

LB 22 "prohibits abortion coverage in health insurance plans offered through state health plans offered through state health insurance exchanges created by federal health care law. "It also prohibits private

health insurance ... from providing coverage for an elective abortion" except for an optional rider for which the insured pays all additional premiums.

LB 521 prevents Web Cam abortions from being preformed in Nebraska as Planned Parenthood plans to expand to five additional citeis in our state. Legislation requires "abortionist be ... present in same room as pregnant woman when abortion is preformed" See SNR page 5 Greg's column for details on this bizarre abortion procedure.

LB 690 "replaces Nebraska's parental notification law ... with requirement that a minor (unemancipated woman" not yet 18) "obtain notarized parental consent from a parent or guardian before obtaining an abortion."
